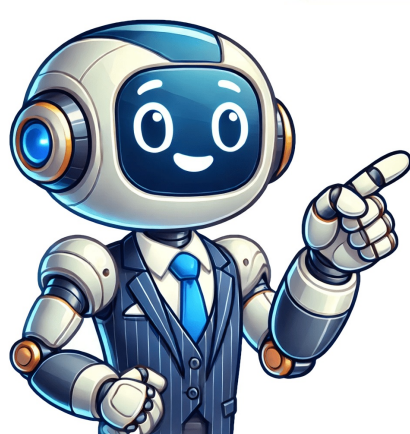

Novelist: A writer of novels. Example: She is a well-known novelist. Numeral: A figure, symbol, or group of figures or symbols denoting a number. Example: The Roman numeral for four is IV. Nonviable: Not capable of working successfully. Example: The project was deemed nonviable. Narcissist: A person who has an excessive interest in or admiration of themselves. Example: He was such a narcissist that he could not stop looking at himself in the mirror. Nestling: A bird that is too young to leave its nest. Example: The mother bird fed the nestling. Nobility: The quality of being noble in character, mind, birth, or rank. Example: His actions showed a sense of nobility. Notational: Relating to notation. Example: The notational system for the music was complex. Nonexempt: Not exempt from something, especially from paying tax. Example: Nonexempt employees are entitled to overtime pay. Nullify: To make legally null and void. Example: The contract was nullified by the court. Nonperishable: Not subject to rapid deterioration or decay. Example: Nonperishable foods are essential for emergency supplies. Nonchalantly: In a casually calm and relaxed manner. Example: She replied nonchalantly to the difficult question. Negligibly: So small or unimportant as to be not worth considering. Example: The cost increase was negligibly small. Needlepoint: Embroidery worked over canvas, typically in a diagonal stitch. Example: She created beautiful designs with needlepoint. Nebulizer: A device that converts liquid medicine into a mist for inhalation. Example: The doctor prescribed a nebulizer for her asthma. Neurotic: Suffering from a nervous disorder. Example: His neurotic behavior made it difficult for him to socialize. Neuropeptide: Any of a group of compounds that act as neurotransmitters. Example: Neuropeptides play a crucial role in brain function. Navigator: A person who directs the route or course of a ship, aircraft, or other form of transport. Example: The navigator plotted a new course. Neighboring: Situated next to or very near. Example: They visited the neighboring towns. Numerical: Relating to or expressed as a number or numbers. Example: The data was arranged in numerical order. Negotiated: Discussed to reach an agreement. Example: They negotiated a fair price for the house.
