There are units out there that have a separate button for Bluetooth.To activate Bluetooth connectivity, simply press and hold the Power/Bluetooth button for about 4 to 5 seconds. Once pairing mode is activated, you'll notice the LED light starting to flash.It's highly likely that the Power On/Off button on the side of your Skullcandy headphones is used to access other modes, so make sure to check the owner's instructions to learn more about it.Locate the Headphones on Your Bluetooth DeviceIn this step, you want to activate Bluetooth connectivity on your device, be it a phone, laptop, or any other Bluetooth-enabled device. Also, you want to make sure your device is visible.Keep in mind that if your Bluetooth-enabled device isn't set to visible, the headphones won't be able to locate it. The headphones should appear on the list of items on your phone or laptop.AndroidTo pair your headphones with your Android device, head to settings, activate Bluetooth, choose "Pair New Device," select your Skullcandy device, and voila! The pairing process is complete.iOSPairing your Skullcandy on an iOS device is similar to pairing it with an Android. Go to settings, activate Bluetooth, search for your Skullcandy in the "Other Devices" section, and then select it.Windows 10On a laptop, click on the Bluetooth button in the toolbar, select "Show Bluetooth Devices," select "Bluetooth & Other Devices," and tap on your Skullcandy headphones to start pairing.If you can't find the Bluetooth button in your toolbar, head to your taskbar at the far bottom of the display screen and you'll find it below the upward arrow. Firstly, they'll sound a beep. And second, the LED light will stop blinking.When you activate Bluetooth connectivity on your headphones, the LED light will begin flashing. Once the pairing process is completed successfully, the LED light will stop its blinking.If you've gone through the pairing steps successfully and you didn't hear the beep sound or see the LED light stop blinking, you need to try again. If it fails, try resetting your headphones.Resetting a pair of Skullcandy headphones is a process that differs from one model to the other. We strongly recommend that you resort to your owner's manual to heed the correct procedure.For most Skullcandy headphones, the reset process will involve you turning off the headphones, holding down the Plus and Minus buttons concurrently, and waiting for the double beep sound.Final ThoughtsWith the aid of the information provided in this article, you should be able to pair any Skullcandy headphones to a Bluetooth-enabled device. Feel free to let us know if you have any questions. Turn on pairing mode for your Skullcandy headphones or speaker Most Skullcandy headphones and earbuds typically share the same button for Power On/Off and Bluetooth pairing. Press and hold the pairing button for 4-5 seconds (varies by device) until you see the LED light start flashing — this indicates the headphones are now in pairing mode. 2. Find your Skullcandy headphones or speaker on your phone or laptop and pair them Android. Go to Settings and turn on Bluetooth. In Bluetooth click "Pair new device". When you see your Skullcandy device come up in the list, tap it and it should be paired with your phone. iPhone. Go to Settings and then Bluetooth. Turn on Bluetooth. Look for your Skullcandy device under "OTHER DEVICES" and tap on it to connect. MacOS. On your Mac, choose Apple menu > System Preferences, then click Bluetooth. Select your Skullcandy device from the list, then click Connect. If asked, click Accept. Windows 10. Open "Bluetooth & other devices" in the System Settings either by clicking on your Bluetooth button in the tool bar and selecting "Show Bluetooth devices". If the Bluetooth button is hidden, you'll find it under the upward arrow on the task bar at the bottom of your display (see below). When the Add a device window comes up, click "Bluetooth". Look for your Skullcandy device in the list and tap on it to connect. Alternatively, search for "Bluetooth" in your Windows search box. When the Bluetooth & other devices window comes up, make sure Bluetooth is on then click "Add Bluetooth or other device" and select your device from the list. 3. Confirm successful pairing When you have successfully paired your Skullcandy headphones or speaker to your phone or laptop, the LED on your JBL device will stop blinking and you should hear an audio confirmation that your device is paired (either a tone or voice confirmation). Troubleshooting your Bluetooth connection If you have followed the steps above and your device still isn't pairing, try resetting your Skullcandy headphones or speaker. For headphones, press the volume up and down buttons at the same time and hold until you hear two short beeps (about 4 seconds). For speakers, hold the center pairing button and the volume up button until you hear two short beeps. This will clear out any old Bluetooth connections and allow to start the pairing process fresh, again. If that doesn't fix your Skullcandy connection problem, try our more detailed guide for fixing Bluetooth pairing problems.
