## How to program xfinity remote codes

1. Turn on your TV and Flex TV Box. Make sure the XR16 remote is also activated as it's designed for the Flex TV Box unit. If you wish to control audio components like soundbars and receivers, turn those on too. The XR16 has a unique design without a numeric keypad, making it easily recognizable. One of its best features is that you don't need to search for component codes for your TV and other devices - the Flex Box takes care of it for you. 2. Set the TV to the correct input by pressing an Input or Source button on your TV's remote until you reach the input connected to your Flex. 3. Pair your XR16 remote with your Flex TV Box. If you've already been using your remote with your Flex Box, skip this step. Otherwise, follow these steps: Point the remote at the Flex Box, press and release the microphone button, and some instructions will appear on the TV screen. Follow the on-screen instructions to pair your remote. When pairing is complete, you'll be asked if you want to use your XR16 remote to control other devices. 4. Press and hold the microphone button and say "Program Remote." This will display information about using your XR remote to control your TV power and volume. 5. Follow the on-screen instructions to program your remote for all components. Since there are no number buttons on the Flex's XR16 remote, all the necessary information is stored within the Flex Box. 1. Turn on your TV. Make sure everything else you want to program into your Xfinity remote is turned on as well. Check the model number inside the battery compartment and insert AA batteries if not already done so. 2. Pair the remote to your X1 TV Box. If setting up your XR15 remote for the first time, pair it with your Xfinity box before proceeding. Press and hold the Xfinity and Info buttons at the same time for about five seconds until the light turns green. A three-digit pairing code will appear; use the numeric keypad to enter the code once validated. 3. Locate the code for each component you want to control on a computer, phone, or tablet by going to in a web browser and selecting XR15 - Voice remote, then TV if desired, and follow the prompts to find and program your codes. To program an XR11 remote for Xfinity, follow these steps: 1 Turn on your TV along with other devices such as the X1 Box or audio receiver to ensure you are using the right remote. 2 Set the correct input by pressing the Input button until you see it highlighted on the screen. 3 Find the code in the second section and choose Audio/Other for components like speakers. 4 Press and hold the Xfinity and Mute buttons simultaneously and release them once a green light appears. 5 Enter your selected TV or component code to complete pairing. To program your Xfinity remote, start by pressing the Up button (CH ^) repeatedly until your TV turns off. Then, press Setup again to save the code. Next, turn your TV back on using the TV button at the top-left. You can find specific codes for each component you want to control on Xfinity's website (. Select your remote model and continue to reveal the code(s) for your desired device. This process is also applicable for remotes without voice options, allowing you to control TV's, audio components like soundbars, and DVD/Blu-Ray players. Power on your television and press the TV button on your Xfinity remote if it's available. Press and hold the Setup or Set button until the light turns green, then enter the programming code for your TV using the number pad. If successful, the green light will flash twice; otherwise, try again. To test, press the Power button on your Xfinity remote. If you've successfully programmed your TV, proceed with controlling other components by following similar steps and entering their respective codes. Remember to turn the TV back on between attempts if needed. This method should be used as a last resort when other methods have been exhausted. If you've run out of codes to try, use this technique to scan for the TV code. However, this method won't work with XR16 or XR15 remotes. To start, press and hold the Setup or Set button on your remote until the light at the top turns green. If you're using an older black component remote, lift your finger when the red light blinks twice. Next, enter 991 using the number pad - the indicator light will flash green two times. Then, repeatedly press the "Channel Up" button until your TV powers off. This process can take some time as it cycles through all available codes. Once you find the correct code, your TV will turn off. To save the code, press the Setup or Set button again and then press the Power button to turn your TV back on. Your remote should now be programmed for use with your TV. If you're still having issues, make sure everything is plugged in securely and can power on manually. This could help rule out any hardware problems. Additionally, try turning everything off and starting from scratch if your remote is behaving erratically. Replace the batteries if your remote is unresponsive or remove any obstructions between your remote and device that may be interfering with the signal. If you are using an Xfinity TV Box with a remote that has a setup button, follow these steps: Turn on your TV and grab the remote for your Xfinity TV Box. Press and hold the Setup button until the LED indicator light changes from red to green. Next, press 9, 9, and 1 using the number buttons on your remote. The LED indicator light will flash a green light. Keep pressing the channel + button until your TV switches off. Then, press the Setup button on the remote to lock in the code for your TV. Once you have entered the correct code, press the Power button on the remote. Grab the XR11 remote control and make sure it has batteries installed. Next, point it at your Xfinity TV Box, ensuring there's nothing obstructing its line of sight. Press the A button, followed by Remote Setup on your remote. The TV Box will prompt you to use the remote for controlling power and volume; select Yes. You'll also be asked if you want to control your TV using the remote - choose Yes again. Enter the correct code for your TV (refer to the list above), then click OK. Once set up, test the remote by pressing the volume and mute buttons. If it doesn't work, try another code. For voice-controlled XR11 remotes, simply point it at the Xfinity Box and press the microphone button; say "Program Remote" to proceed with the setup process.
