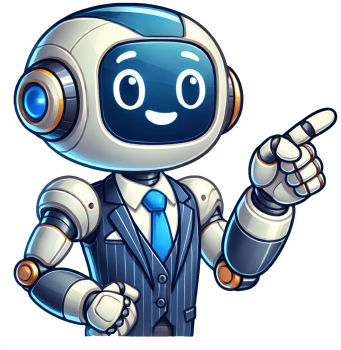

## How to get 2fa fortnite gifting

Visit Epic Games’ website and sign in with the Nintendo-linked Epic account. Epic Games rewards players who enable 2FA with exclusive in-game items and features. It is an effective way to enhance account security and protect it from unauthorized access. Hackers would obtain accounts through keylogging, phishing and others methods in order to sell the accounts. Last time the feature was available in the game, it only last for four days - available from February 18th to February 22nd.So will the gifting feature be removed again on Friday?
