There are a lot of shortcuts to change the color of your Ducky 1 and 2 Mini keyboards. You can press the Fn+Alt+T on your keyboard to switch between different RGB modes. There are 10 different RGB modes among which 6 are color customizable by customizing the brightness of the Red, Blue and Green color. Press Caps Lock + Z/X/C to manage the brightness of Red, Blue and Green color respectively. You can also press Caps Lock + Space to access the whole color palette to makes the keyboard glow with a specific color. How do you use a ducky keyboard? Ducky Keyboard is a 60% RGB mechanical keyboard that provides a really compact form factor. But this compact form factor makes the keyboard short on some of the most used keys whose functionality is achieved via keyboard shortcuts. So, in order to use the Ducky or any other 60% keyboard you'll need to learn its keyboard shortcuts. How do I adjust the brightness on my Ducky One 2 Mini? The keyboard shortcuts Fn + Alt + Z/X/C will let you adjust the brightness of the Red, Blue, and Green colors of your Ducky One 2 Mini keyboard. What are the best switches for Ducky One 2 Mini? The Ducky One 2 Mini comes with different types of Cherry MX switches which are known for very tactile mechanical keystroke. There are Cherry MX Browns, Blue, Black and Red switches. There is nothing wrong with having any of these key switches. But I personally love to gave the MX Black switches because they are more likely to be the retooled variant. However, if you like to type on a quiet keyboard then you can opt for MX Red switches. Bottom Line So there were all the Ducky One 2 Mini keyboard shortcuts that you can use on your new keyboard.
