The gist is that you'll turn on Airplane Mode right before you watch a story, which will keep Instagram from knowing you saw it since you won't be connected to their servers while watching. Open Instagram and go to the profile of the person you want to watch stories from. Wait for the stories to load at the top of their profile. Turn on Airplane Mode to temporarily disable your phone's network capabilities. This will disconnect you from both Wi-Fi and mobile data. If you don't know how to turn on Airplane Mode, you can do so from the Notification Panel on Android and the Control Center on iOS. Tap the story you want to view. Once you're done watching it, close the Instagram app entirely and turn Airplane Mode off. Use a website like storysaver.net to view public stories anonymously. If the story you want to view is on a public profile, you can watch it (and even download it) at this. It is much safer than using a third-party app that asks for your login information, as that can lead to your account getting disabled by Instagram or your information being stolen from a shady app developer. Go to and enter the username of the Instagram account you want to view the stories of. Click the Download! button and complete a CAPTCHA (if required). Perform a half-swipe to get a peek at a story. If you half-swipe on another person's story, you won't be able to watch that person's story either. Instead, you'll see the thumbnail of the next story in the feed. This means you can work in some situations. Open Instagram and tap the previous story to the one you want to half-swipe. Note that this will show the entire story whether you viewed part of it already. You can also scroll down the feed until you reach the bottom-most story. Then, touch and hold the thumb icon in the bottom-left corner of the screen. A small menu will pop up. Tap "View the whole story." This will take you to the full version of the story. People who've added you to their Close Friends list. If someone has added you as a Close Friend, they will be given a green star icon by their notes, reels, and stories. You also may see a green ring around their profile picture.[2] If you view a story of someone who's added you to a Close Friends list, it'll show that a "Close Friend" viewed their story but not show your username. This isn't completely anonymous, as the user will know that one of their Close Friends has watched their story, and you may be the only person on their Close Friends list. You need to send a follow request to the user first. If they approve the follow request, you can view their stories. Question How can I see a private account? A private account's photos and videos can't be viewed unless you are following them (you need to send a request to them first and wait for them to say yes to it), but you can see their profile picture, their bio, and their username, as well as the number of how many users are following them and who they are following (but only their followers can see the lists). There are four sure-shot ways to view Instagram Stories anonymously, and the one I often use is watching Stories through my secondary Instagram account, which no one knows about. However, if you don't have a secondary Instagram account, I do have other workarounds for you. Using Airplane Mode is the simplest way to view someone's Instagram story without your username appearing in the seen viewer's list. However, this method works only for a single story as there will be no internet connection for the next story to load, which is the basic requirement to view multiple Stories. Here's how you can do it: In the Instagram app, open the profile of the person whose story you want to watch. Scroll down to the top of the profile where the story banner is located. Tap on the story to open it. While the story is loading, quickly switch to Airplane Mode by pulling down the status bar and toggling off the airplane mode icon. Once the story loads, watch it discreetly. Afterward, return to normal network settings. Instagram app completely before turning off the Airplane mode ensures your view stays hidden. Several third-party apps and websites, such as InLook, offer functionalities that the official Instagram app might never offer. One such functionality is the ability to view Instagram Story just by entering the Instagram username. Some third-party websites such as StoriesIG and Insta Stories Viewer, also allow you to download Instagram Stories. However, exercising caution when using these third-party apps and websites is important, as they pose privacy and security risks. One should avoid entering any private information whenever possible. Another straightforward way to view someone's Instagram story anonymously is to use a secondary Instagram account. If you don't already have a secondary account, you can easily create one. Here's how: In your Instagram feed, tap the account story before the one you want to view anonymously. Here, touch & hold and swipe right partially to view the first frame of the next Instagram account's story. You can make out what's happening by viewing the first frame of the Instagram story without registering your name in the viewer's list. To view the last frame of the intended story, open the Instagram account story next to it, then touch & hold and make a partial left swipe. Incognito mode activated... It is not a direct private IG account photo viewer, but it can provide information on the username. During the research, I came across a few profiles that matched the criteria. I used Spokeo to find out the names of the individuals who had posted pictures and a few photos. I also received multiple other useful information about them, such as their hobbies, interests, addresses, email ID, marital status, etc. One of the issues with Spokeo is that, at times, you may receive incomplete information. However, I was notified via email whenever any updates or changes occurred on my existing report. How to use Spokeo to view Instagram Private Account Photos: Step 1) To view private Instagram account photos, I am using its Username search. I tried this method and got my piece of interest to accept my follow request. It takes some effort, and your account will already have the New Tag, which raises doubts. Hence, you can start by choosing an authentic-looking profile pic (you can find some on the web or Pinterest). Then, use a genuine-sounding username, but it must be poles apart from your real name. Post at least 3 to 5 photos and add a small bio, plus mention that your previous account was hacked. For example, I wrote, "Just here to soak up good vibes. The previous acct got hacked, starting over with this one." Make sure your following and follower ratio is reasonable, for example, at least get above 60 followers and follow no more than 100-120 people. Get your friends to like your posts and leave some genuine comments
