Running the emulator will require you to have a system image, an additional tool to your toolset. Each platform version contains the supported system images. You can download these system images while creating Android Virtual Devices (AVDs) within its manager. Simply select either Intel or ARM-based on your development computer's processor.Android SDK platformTo compile your apps, you're required to have at least one platform in your environment. While to provide the best user experience on your latest devices, you'll need to have the latest platform version as your build target. You'll still be able to run your app on older versions but you must build against the latest version in order to utilize new functions featured when running on devices with the latest OS version.In order to properly run this set of tools, you'll need an Integrated Development Environment (IDE). Although the SDK can be used to write programs in the command prompt, the most common method is by using an IDE. This is where Android Studio comes in, it allows you to compile and edit your code, or test your app before releasing it on Google Play. Installing Android Studio is also the easiest way to get a working set of tools on your PC. It will also keep your Android SDK tools up to date with its automatic updates and the Android SDK Manager.This set of Android development tools is easy to set up and run.
