One of the most common non-specific blocks is called epidural steroid injection. The full nerve blocks include an injection of drugs, typically an anesthetic or anti-inflammatory drug, to stop the signal traveling along the affected nerves or refresh the inflammation in the area. In other words, the dose is kept low to avoid temporary paralysis.
