






If you have a Facebook account and occasionally want to try out some weird photo editing app, VPN service, "premium" 3D game, or even a business tool from Google Play or the Apple App Store without carefully reading reviews and user feedback, your social media credentials, they may be in danger and require immediate attention. As much as we'd like to blame the latest mobile security blunder on some weird mistake by Google or Apple that both tech giants can learn from and make sure it never happens again, the truth is... different and pretty easy to figure out. guesswork. This means that if you have reason to fear that you are a victim of this massive malware distribution campaign, you should change your social media password immediately. If you have a Facebook account and want to try a weird photo editing app, a VPN service, a "high-end" 3D game or even a business tool from Google Play or the Apple App Store once in a while, Without closely examining user ratings and reviews, chances are your social media credentials have been compromised and require immediate attention. While we'd like to attribute the latest mobile security problem to an unusual mistake by Google or Apple that both tech giants can learn from and will surely never happen again, the truth is... different and pretty easy to guess. As usual, Google can only rid the Play Store of all malicious titles listed below, which reportedly happened relatively quickly. The sheer number of apps you must avoid is quite remarkable, as is Apple's laxity in dealing with an admittedly related group of fake iOS business apps. All these apps (Android and iOS) had one thing in common. That requires users to log in to Facebook before they can access those apps' features and functionality, which should be an important red flag. Unfortunately, many people seem to have ignored this warning without delving too deeply into reviews of these apps since their Facebook usernames and passwords were stolen through an insecure login process. How to get rid of pre-installed apps Edgars Cervantes / Android Authority All Android devices come with several different pre-installed apps. This may include some useful programs that most people don't mind, such as Gmail, YouTube, Facebook, etc. However, there's also a good chance that your device has pre-installed from your device as easily as the ones you downloaded yourself. So, if you use any of the three options above, the Uninstall button will not appear at the end of the process, as shown in the image below. Apps that cannot be deleted are called system apps and the only way to get rid of them is to root your device. If you're not familiar with the term, rooting simply means gaining access to commands, system files, and folder locations that are normally off-limits to users. The only way to get rid of system applications is to root your device. Rooting by Mitja Rutnik can be seen as a transition from system apps you don't want to use from the app drawer if your device allows it. This won't remove any apps, but at least it won't fill the app drawer. Another solution is to disable pre-installed apps. This doesn't remove them, but it does prevent them from running in the background and hides them from the app drawer. You can do this by going to the Settings app. Go to Apps, find the pre-installed app, select it and click Disable. Click Disable Application to confirm the action. Step by step instructions.
